TORRE DEL MARE SEA TOWER - sleeps 2

124 square metres + 64 square metres roof terraceLower level: living room and 1 bathroom with Jacuzzi bath and shower.Upper level: 1 double bedroom with king-size bed, oversized arched window with sea view, fridge and air conditioning. Private roof terrace with sun loungers.

TORRE DEL GIGLIO - sleeps 2 + 2 children

64 square metres + 64 square metres roof terrace9 metre high wooden ceilings on 2 levelsLower floor: 1 double bedroom with queen-size bed and iron fireplace at 9 m height, 1 bathroom with mini-pool bathtub and shower. Villa Argentaia is more than just a noble holiday residence. During the extensive renovation of the abandoned monastery, ancient building techniques dating back as late as to the Romans were combined with modern construction methods in order to preserve the old structure and character of the property and to optimize water and energy consumption by conserving resources. The living room, which is dominated by a four-metre-high fireplace, is an oasis of luxury and comfort. Another highlight is the ultra-modern kitchen. Each suite at Villa Argentaia has been designed and furnished with attention to detail. With innovative features such as natural air circulation systems and modern amenities such as underfloor heating, these suites offer unrivaled relaxation.
